

Crl.OP No.12576 of 2015**P.N.PRAKASH,J.**

The petitioner apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 3(2)a, 4(1), and 5(1)a of I.T.P. Act of 1956 in Crime No.102/2014 and seek anticipatory bail.

2.This is third Anticipatory Bail application. The petitioner was involved in two previous cases. The two earlier bail applications were dismissed by this Court, by a well considered order.

3.The learned additional Public Prosecutor submits that there is no change in present situation.

4.From a perusal of the materials available on record, this Court finds that from the statement of one Rema, a victim girl, the involvement of the petitioner has come to light. In view of the serious nature of the allegations and no change of situation, this petition is dismissed.
