Therefore, this petition is closed with a liberty to the petitioner to go in person to give copy of the complaint dated 14.04.2015 to the Inspector of Police of the concerned jurisdiction and on such complaint being given, the same shall be enquired into and action shall be taken in accordance with

law as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari Vs Government of Uttarpradesh and Others reported in (2014) 2 SCC 1.

4.With the above observation, this petition is closed.

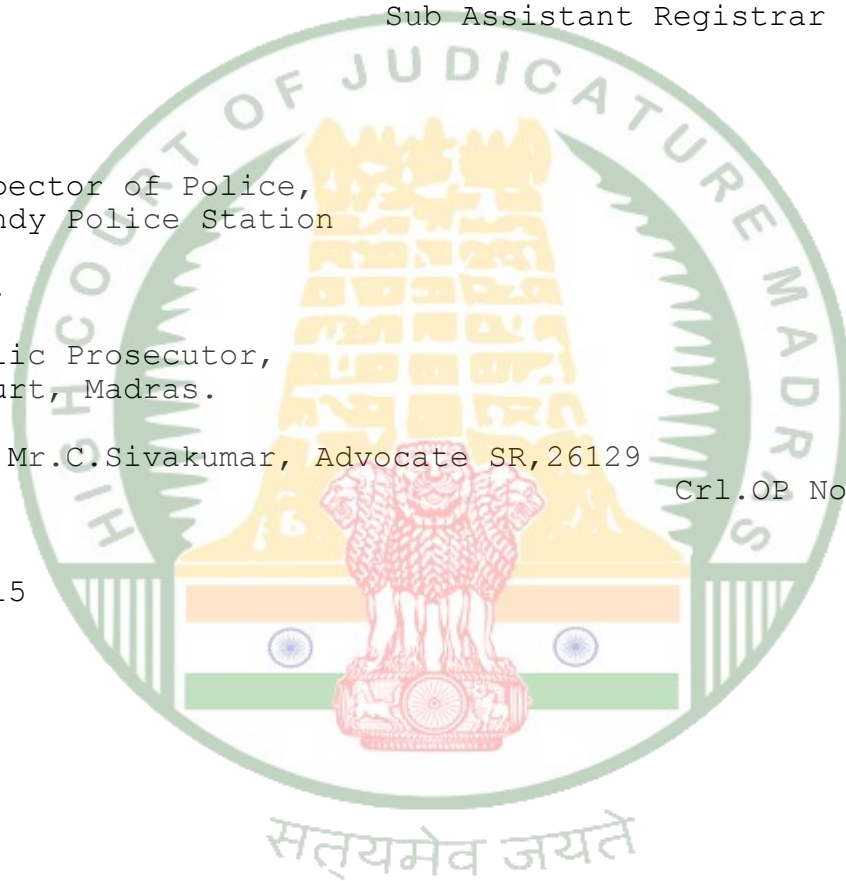
