2. Learned Government Pleader states that the order

3. The petitioner is, thus, directed to submit the aforesaid particulars within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Learned Government Pleader states that on the particulars being submitted, the amount will be remitted within four weeks thereafter.

4. The aforesaid statement is taken on record. The copy of the proceedings be communicated to the petitioner. If the petitioner is not satisfied with the said proceedings, it is open for her to challenge the same in separate proceedings. The Contempt Petition accordingly stands closed.
