ORDER

In the light of the above, the writ petition is closed by recording the true copy of the memo of compromise dated 12.10.2015, in and by which, the petitioner and the fourth respondent have agreed that the fourth respondent will continue the payment of the monthly salary for the employees, who are maintaining accounts with AXIS Bank and disburse the monthly salary to the employees into their account with the AXIS Bank. The true copy of the memo of compromise dated 12.10.2015 is placed on record and it shall form part of this order. No costs. Consequently, the above MPs are also closed.

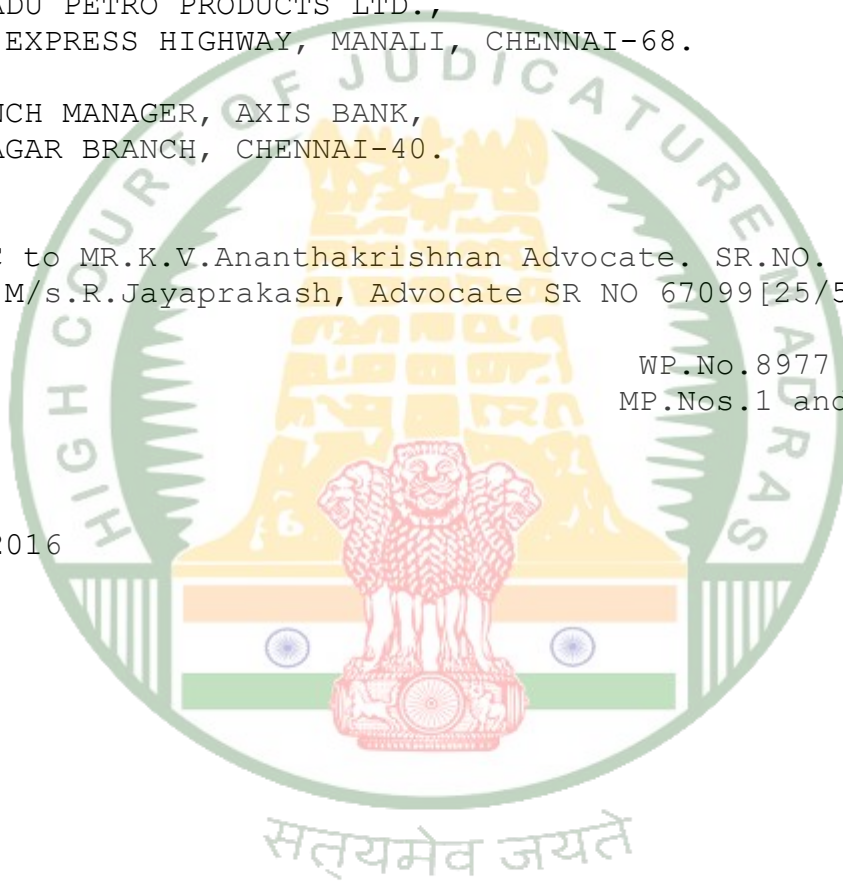
