PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent to disburse amount of Rs.82,554/- with accrued interest to the petitioner each out of the available amount of Rs.3,09,582.23/- vide S.B.Account No.10710458186 of Avudiyappan/ deceased father of petitioners by considering their representation dated 27.12.2013.

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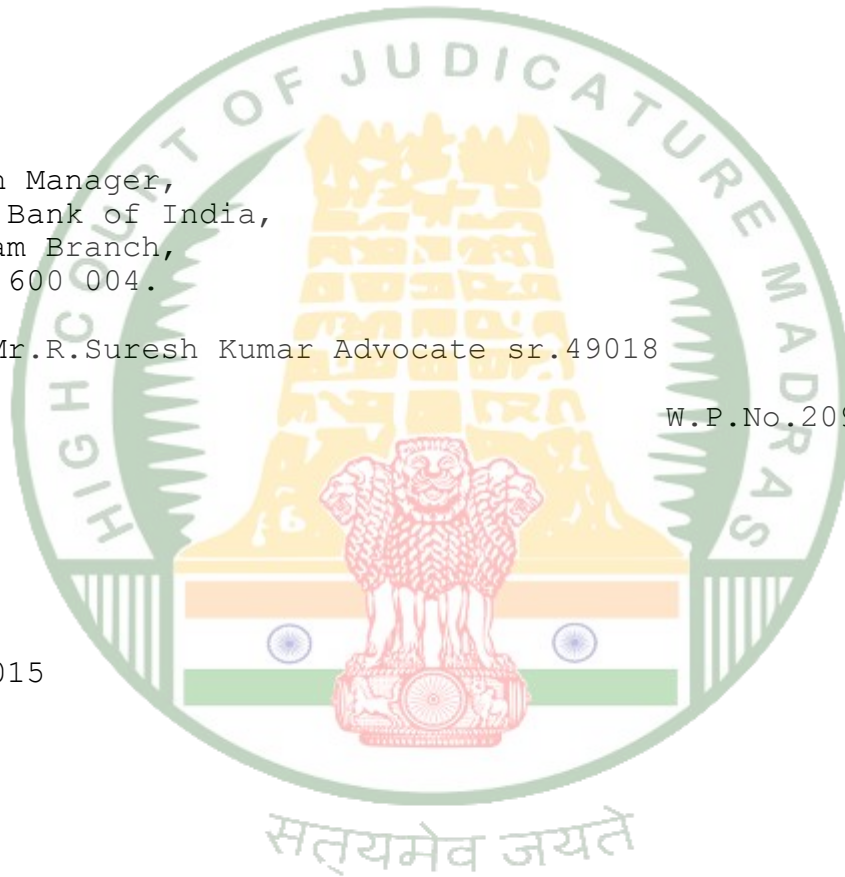
