H.C.P. has been filed to issue a writ of Habeas Corpus directing the detaining authority to produce the detenu, the petitioner's son R.Parthiban, son of Rajabathar @ Rajabadhar, male aged about 23 years resident of No.23, Pilliyar Koil Street, Mettukuppam, Maduravoyil, Chennai-600 095 now detained under Act 14 of 1982 after having been declared as a "Goonda" by order of the second respondent under the preventive detention order dated 29.7.2014 in BDFGISSV No.839 of 2014 and presently confined at the Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai, quash the same set aside the same set the detenu at liberty.
