4.Though the petitioner prayed for a larger relief, this Court in the facts and circumstances of the case, permits the petitioner to submit one more representation to the respondent by enclosing the copy of the earlier application dated 21.12.2012 within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of

this order and the respondent on receipt of the same is directed to consider and pass orders in accordance with law within a period of four weeks thereafter. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

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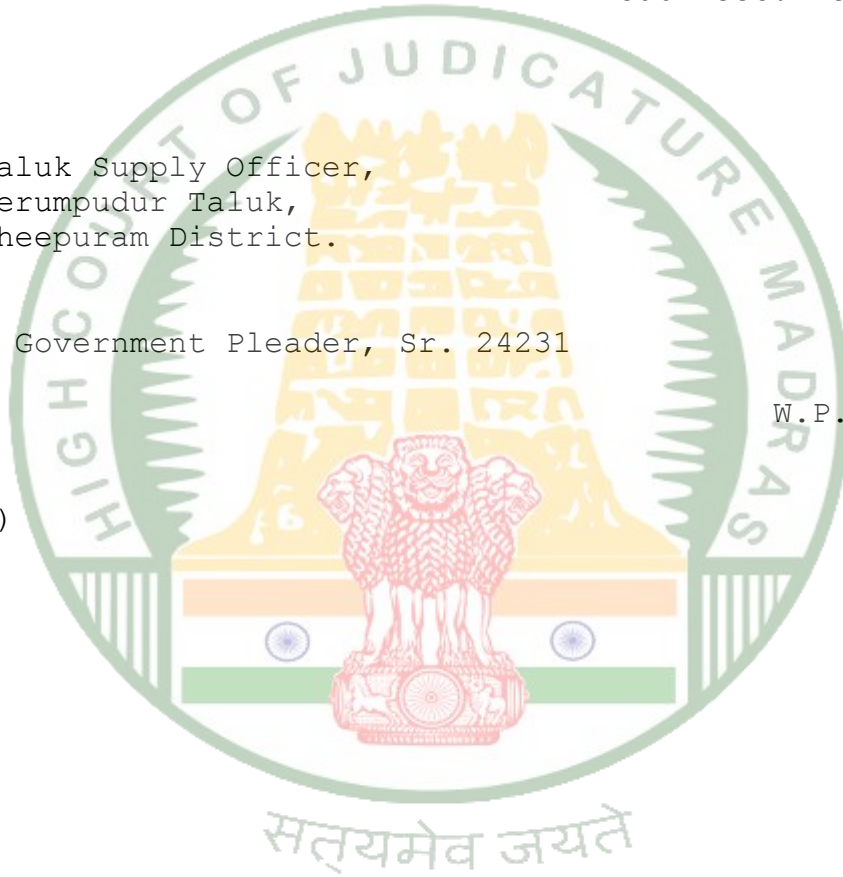
