2. Heard Mr.R.Srinivasa Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner
and Mr.C.Emalias, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for
the respondents.

3. On a reading of the complaint, it essentially appears to be a
dispute between the contractor and his client. As the complaint does
not disclose any cognizable offense, positive direction cannot be
issued to the police to register complaint. However, the petitioner
is at liberty to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

4. With the above observation, the criminal original petition is dismissed.

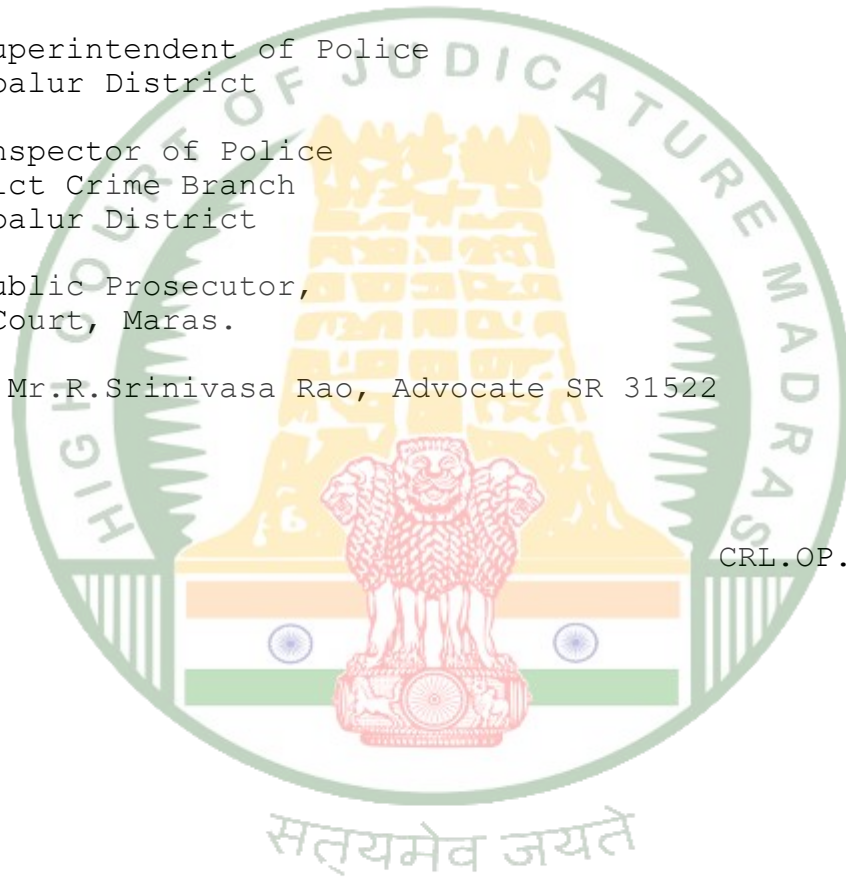
