Deputy Superintendent of Police (Category-I) for the year 2013-2014 for the total 141 posts approved by the Government by including the name of the petitioners and by promoting the petitioners to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Category I) for the year 2013-2014 in the available vacancy in terms of the undertaking given in the Additional affidavit, dated 27.08.2014 filed by the respondents in W.P.No.2727 and 3701 of 2014 from 27.12.2014 being the date when all the 98 persons in the temporary panel were promoted.

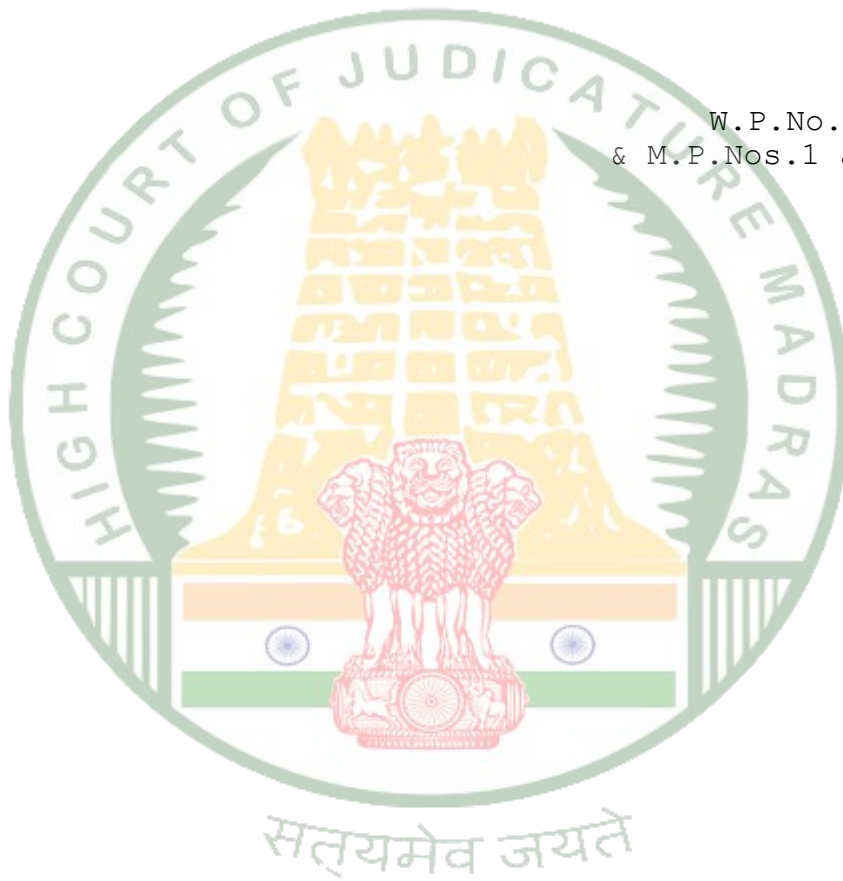
