3.It appears that out of 83 witnesses cited in the final report, 68 witnesses have been examined by the prosecution. It is also represented that five of the accused had died in the mean time.

4.Under such circumstances, the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ooty is directed to expedite the trial in C.C.No.234 of 2005 and complete within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

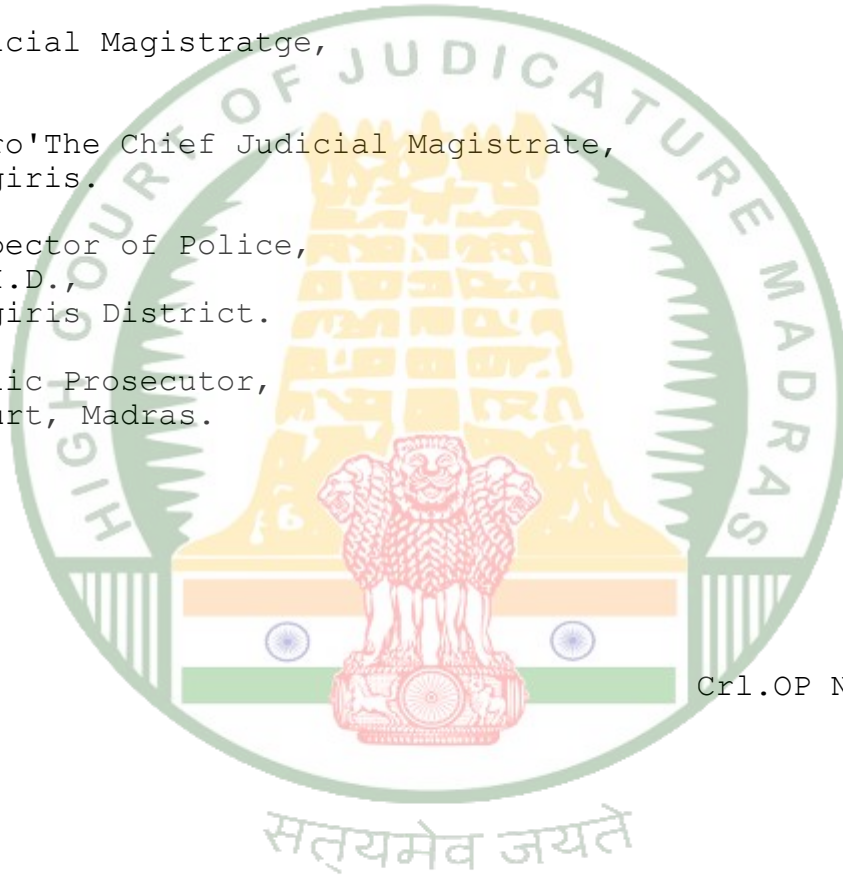
