ORDER

2.The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner, submits that this Court by order dated 5.6.2014, in W.P.No.14434/2014, directed the second respondent therein viz. the respondent herein, to pass an appropriate order after hearing the alleged encroachers including the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order. The said authority, without issuing a notice, passed an order dated 11.7.2014, directing the persons mentioned therein including the petitioner, to remove the encroachment within a period of one week, under the caption "Notice" and as such, this amounts to violation of the order passed by this Court.

3.We have examined the afore-stated order dated 11.7.2014, which is issued under the caption "Notice" with a direction to remove the encroachment within a period of one week. The said communication be treated as a show cause notice as directed by us earlier, with liberty granted to the noticee to file her representation within a period of two weeks from today. Thereafter, the authorities are directed to take appropriate action as directed earlier by us on 5.6.2014, in W.P.No.14434/2014.

4.The contempt petition accordingly, stands disposed of with liberty aforesaid. No costs.

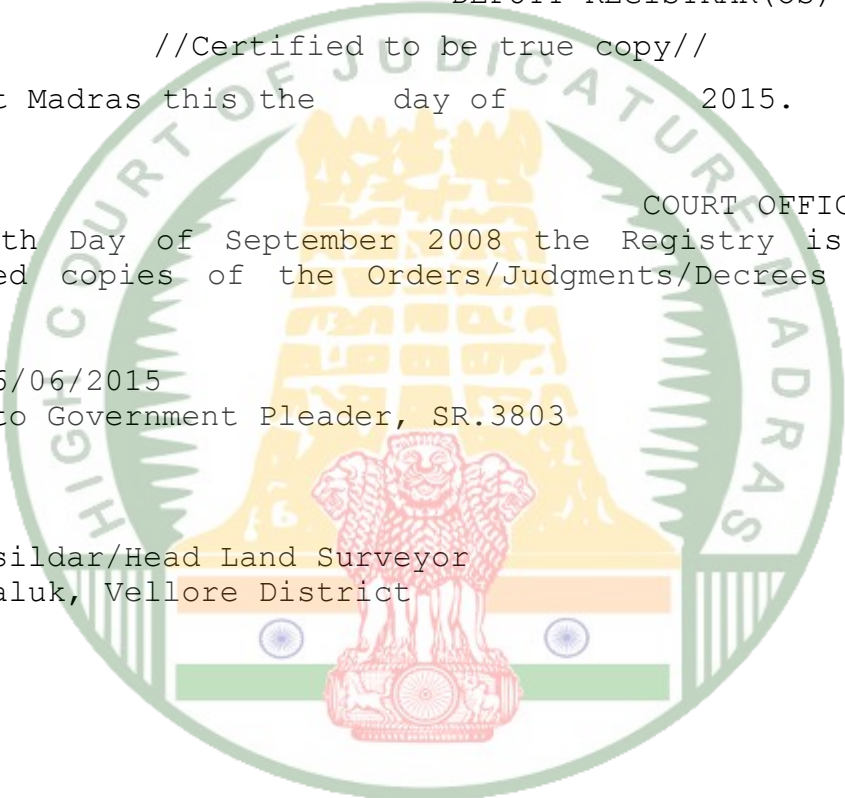
