5. This writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

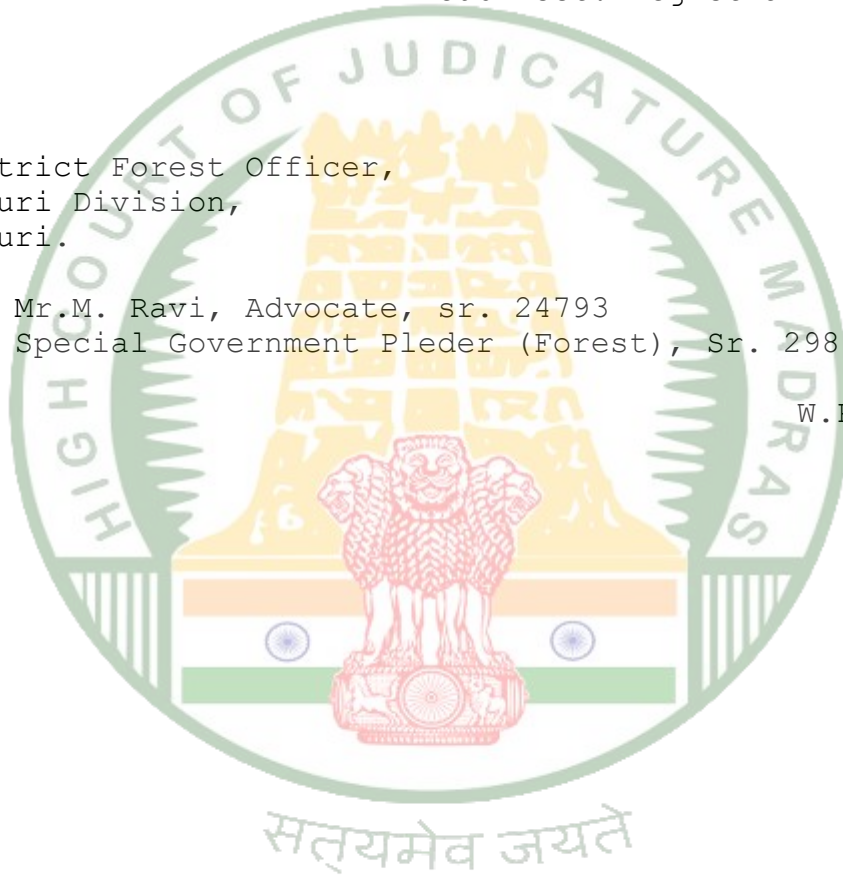
