2. The respondent police has filed the status report dated 13.07.2015 wherein the respondent police narrated the various steps taken to secure the detenu. The report further states that it is a case of matrimonial discord and therefore taking note of the said report, we find no case for illegal detention.

Accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed with a direction to the respondent police to proceed with the investigation and keep the petitioner informed about the developments.

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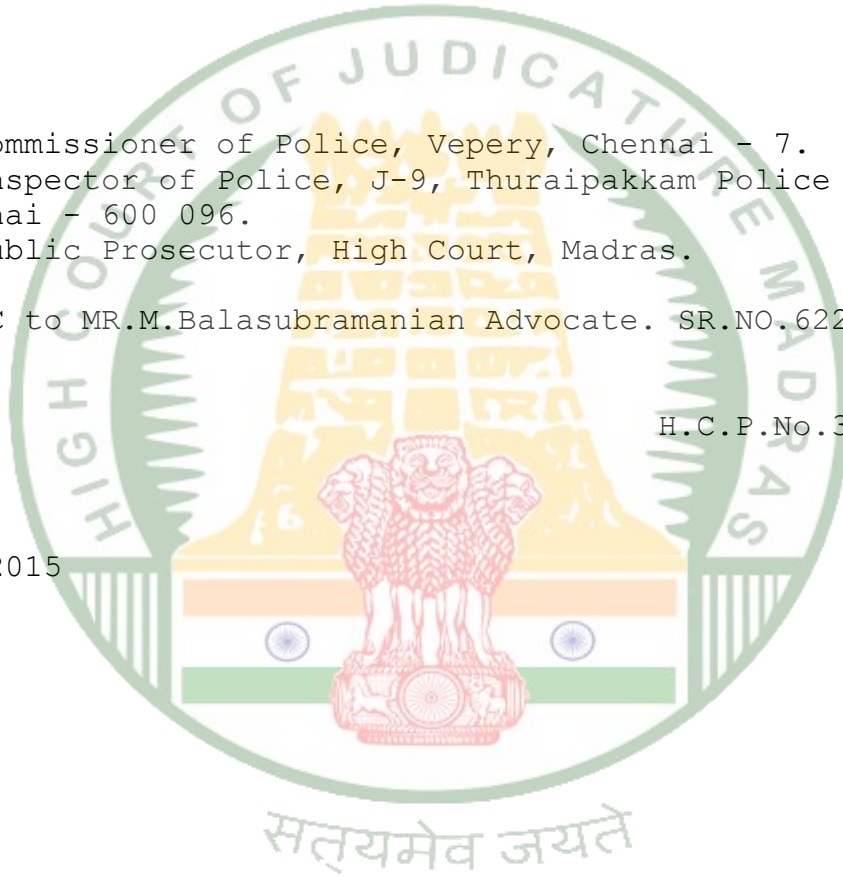
