Habeas Corpus Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus calling for the records of the first respondent culminating with the order of detention bearing BDFGISSV No.1870/2014 dated 17.11.2014 passed by the first respondent herein detaining petitioner's husband Sabastin under Section Act XIV of 1982 and to quash the same and to direct the respondents to produce the body of the person of the detenu Sabastin, son of Arputharaj, Male, aged about 30 years, before this Court, now detained in the Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai and thereby set him at liberty.

The petitioner, who is the wife of the detenu Sabastin, son of Arputharaj, Male, aged about 30 years, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order in No. BDFGISSV No.1870/2014 dated 17.11.2014 passed by the first respondent against her husband branding him as a "Goonda" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982].

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the first respondent as against the husband of the petitioner dated 17.11.2014 has been revoked by the Government in G.O. [Rt] No.404, Home, Prohibition & Excise [XIII] Department dated 19.01.2015 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
