Prayer:- Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus directing the 2nd respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural program in Jingal Kathram Patti, Sri Kaliyamman & Sri Pattamal Temple festival scheduled to be held on 10.06.2015 at Jingal Kathram Patti, Pochampalli Taluk, Krishnagiri District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 29.05.2015.

ORDER

By consent, the writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

2. The petitioner claims to be the president of the festival committee of Jingal Kathram Patti, Sri Kaliyamman & Sri Pattamal Temple at Jingal Kathram Patti, Pochampalli Taluk, Krishnagiri District. He has submitted a representation on 29.05.2015 to the 2nd respondent seeking permission to conduct cultural programme which includes song and dance programme on date of temple festival on 10.06.2015 between 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. and though it was received and acknowledged by the 2nd respondent, so far he has not been favoured with any response. Hence, he has come forward with this writ petition.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would, on instructions, submit that while conducting the temple festival, cultural and dance programme will be performed and there will not be any vulgarity or obscenity and the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent to consider the representation made by the petitioner.

4. Mrs. P. Rajalakshmi, the learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice for the respondents, would submit that within a specified time the application/representation of the petitioner will be considered and disposed of.

5. Though the petitioner prayed for a positive direction, taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made on either side, this court directs the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner's application/representation dated 10.06.2015 in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders on the same on or before 08.06.2015 and communicate the decision taken to the petitioner.

6. This writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
