ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2.

2. This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is the father of the detinue, namely, Kalaiselvi, aged about 33 years. He had filed the Habeas Corpus Petition praying that this court may be pleased to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to produce the detinue, namely, Kalaiselvi, before this Court and to set her liberty, forthwith.

3. At the stage of the hearing the detinue, namely, Kalaiselvi was secured and produced before this court. On being enquired, the detinue stated that she had been away from her family due to misunderstanding. Further, the detinue stated that she is willing to go along with her father, the petitioner herein.

4. In view of the statement made by the detinue, who has been produced before this court, by the second respondent police, we find it appropriate to permit her to go with her father, the petitioner herein. The Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed as no further orders are necessary.
