2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

3. On a reading of the complaint dated 03.07.2015, it is seen that the petitioner had permitted his servant to occupy a portion of the house and that she is not vacating the premises and she is also using the other amenities like water, sewage etc.,

4. In the considered opinion of this Court, no positive direction can be given to the respondent Police to register a case, as the complaint does not disclose commission of cognizable offence. Hence, this petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to work out the remedy in the manner known to law.

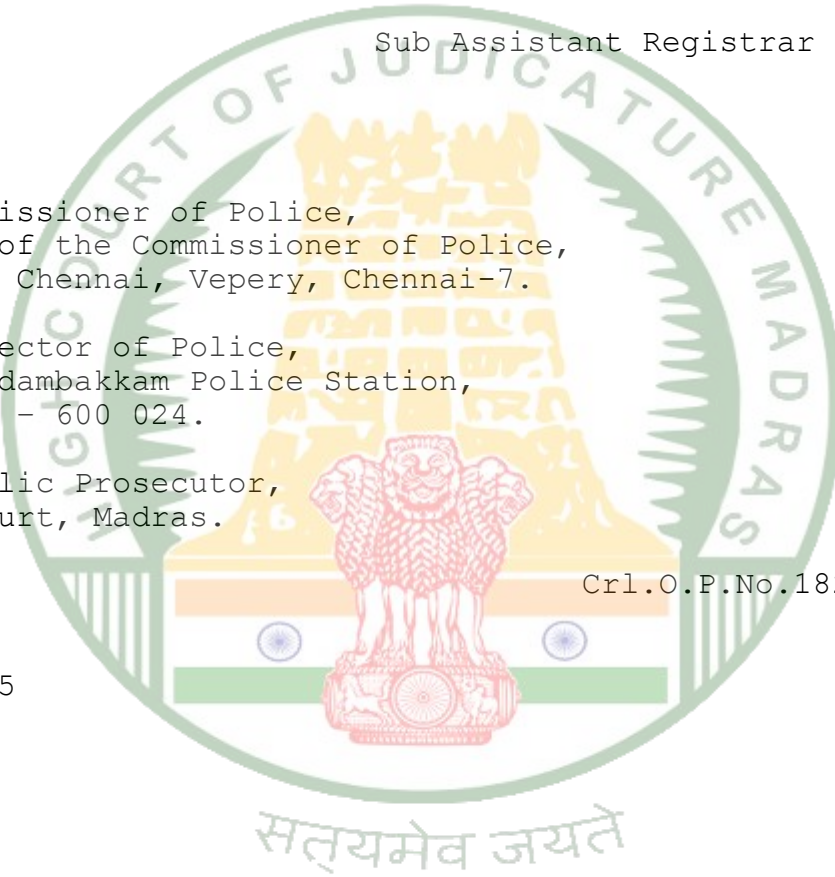
