By consent, the main Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal.

2. The petitioner claims to be a resident of Kannukaranur, Valapady Taluk, Salem District. 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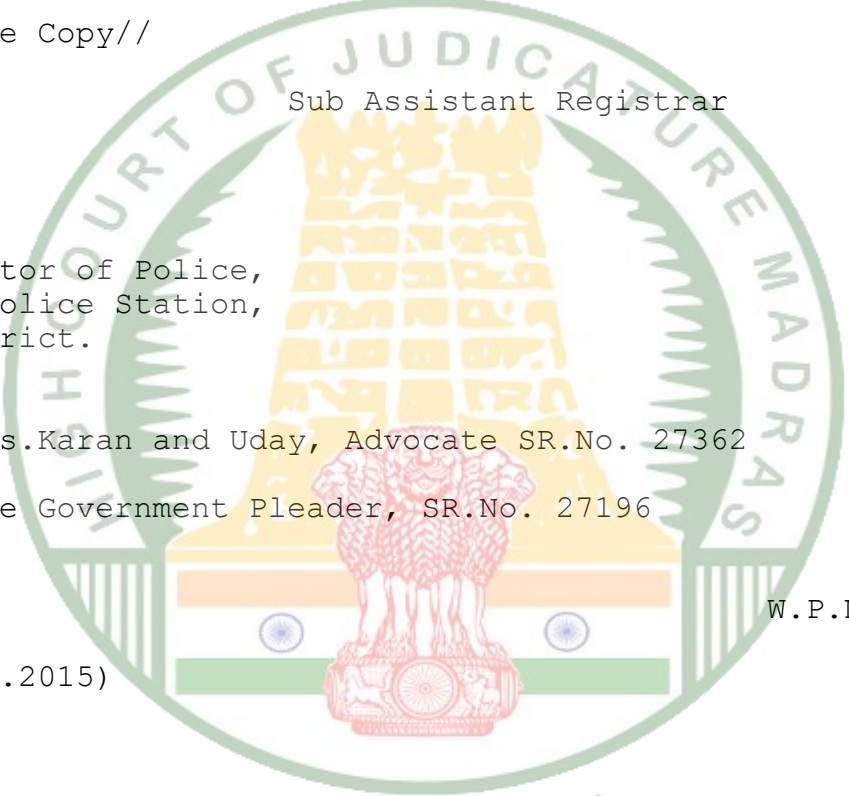
