At the stage of hearing of the Habeas Corpus Petition, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondents had placed before this Court an order passed by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Virdhunagar District at Srivilliputhur, dated 06.01.2015, in CrI.MP.No.25/2015. From the said order, it could be seen that the detenu/accused, A.Nagarajan, who had been arrested and remanded to judicial custody, in connection with the case in Cr.No.456/2014, on the file of Thalavaipuram Police Station, had been released on bail subject to compliance of certain conditions.

2.In such circumstances, no further orders are necessary and the present Habeas Corpus Petition stands dismissed.

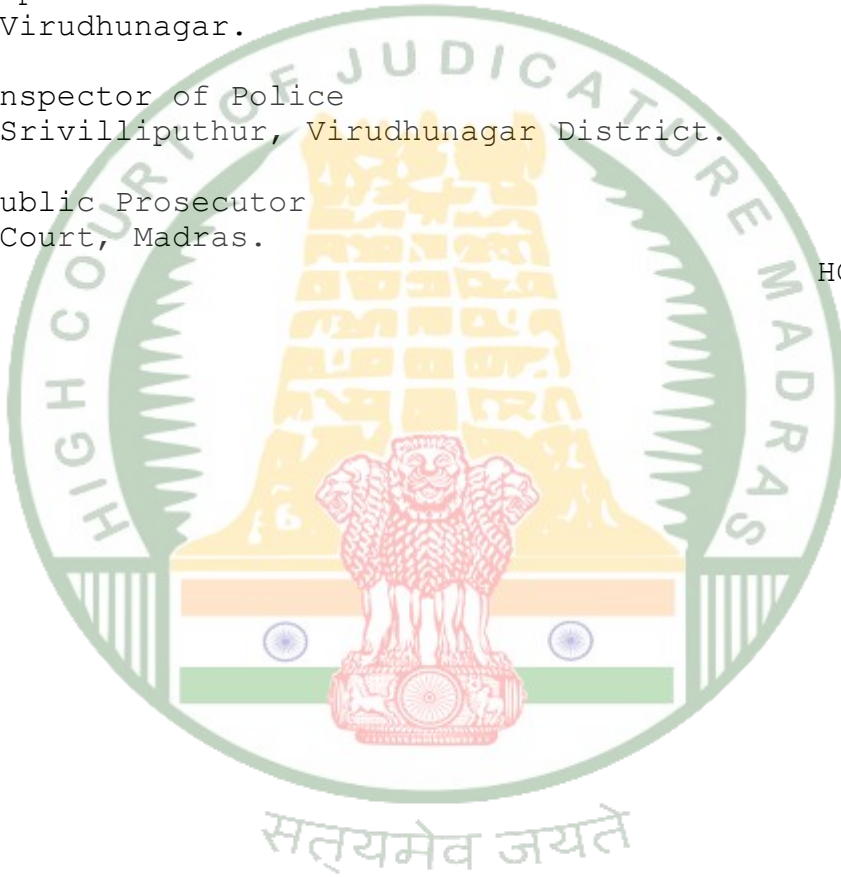
