O R D E R

This Writ Petition is filed, seeking for issue of a Writ, in the nature of mandamus, directing the second respondent to reimburse the training cost in terms of the claim format submitted by the petitioner-Management on 06.01.2015.

2. By an order, dated 02.12.2014, the petitioner was informed that his request for reimbursement of the training cost would be considered for recommendation, subject to the petitioner complying with the deficiencies pointed.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has already informed about the compliance.

4. In reply, the learned Special Government Pleader for respondents 1 to 3 submitted that the petitioner has to inform about the date of proposed inspection.

5. This Court is not inclined to go into the said issue. According to the petitioner, he has complied with the deficiencies pointed out by the respondent-Department. Therefore, the respondent, is expected to conduct inspection. Accordingly, a direction is issued to the second respondent to conduct inspection within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. After being satisfied with the inspection, proper recommendation will have to be made for reimbursement of the training cost in terms of the claim format submitted by the petitioner. While doing so, the second respondent will have to take into consideration of the recommendation made by the Nodal Authority as well.

In the result, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.

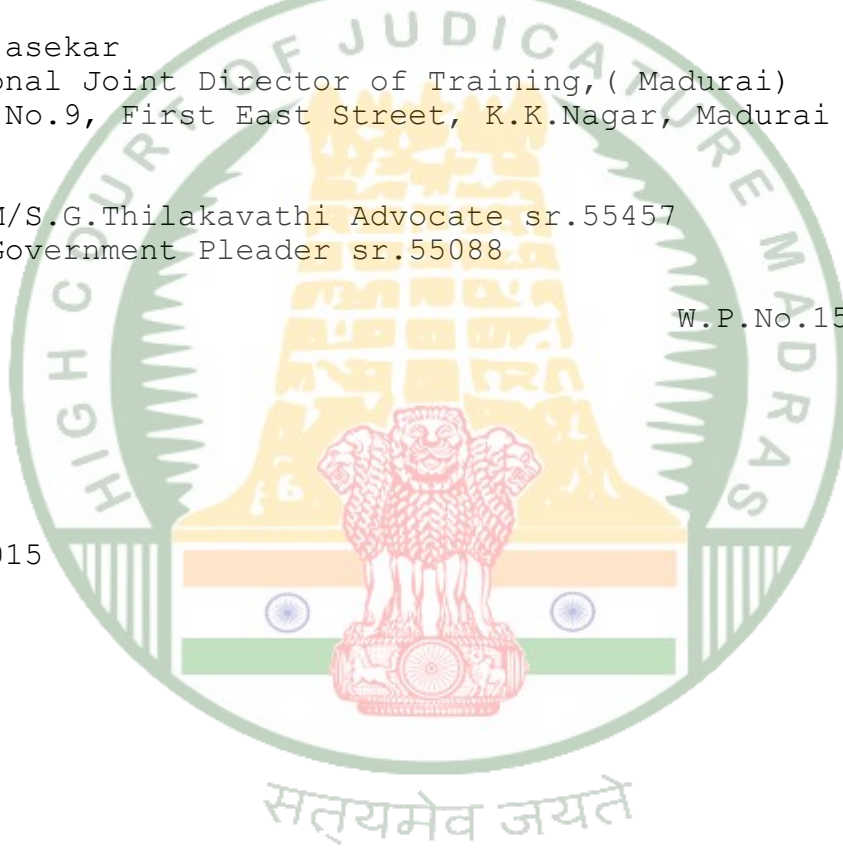
