Under such circumstances, a blanket order of not to harass cannot be granted and the petitioner is also directed to co-operate with the enquiry and during the enquiry, he shall not be harassed.

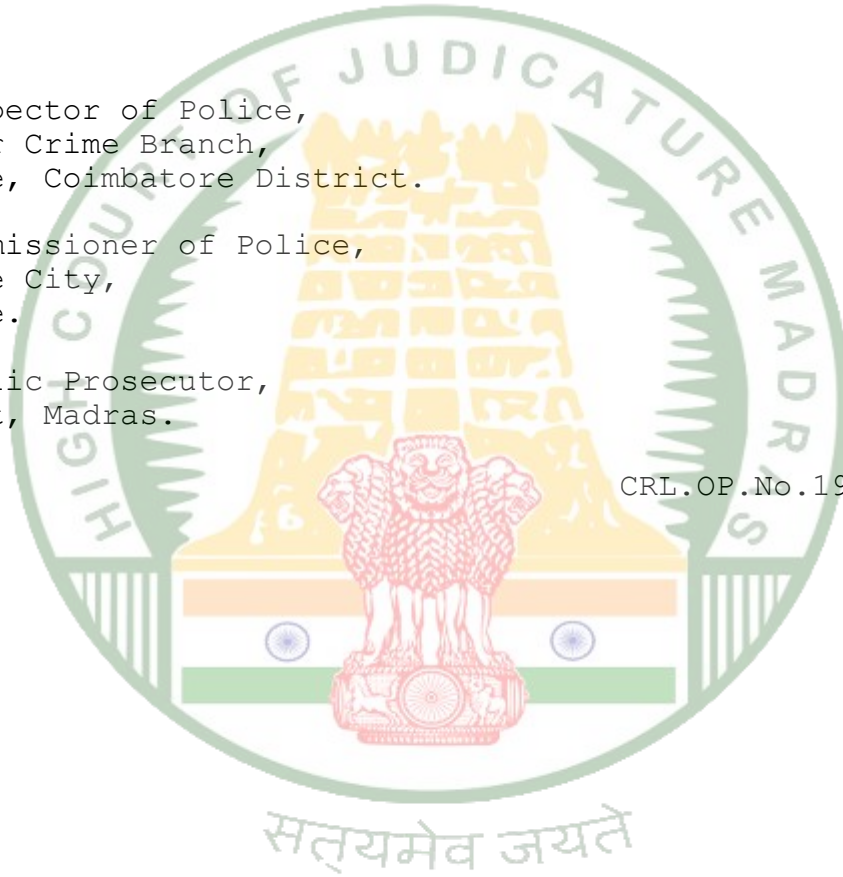
