Prayer in W.P.No.16882 of 2015: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to consider the petitioner's representation given to the respondents 1 and 2 on 06.06.2015 in respect of Catering & Bakery Stall [S-21] (T-14, T-16, T-17, T-19 and T-21), platform No.3 and 4 at Villupuram Railway Station.

Prayer in W.P.No.16922/2015: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, Order or direction, in the nature of a Writ, and calling for the records pertaining to the representation given to the respondents 2 and 1 by the petitioner on 6.6.2015, in respect of catering & Bakery Stall (S20) Platform No.4 & 5 Villupuram Railway Station and to consider the petitioner's representation dated 06.06.2015.

Prayer in W.P.No.16923: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, Order or direction, in the nature of a Writ and calling for the records pertaining to the representation given to the respondents 2 and 1 by the petitioner on 6.6.2015 in respect of Snacks & TA Stall, Travel Amenities Stall (S23) Platform No.6 at Villupuram Railway Station and to consider the petitioner's representation dated 06.06.2015.

Prayer W.P.No.16972/2015: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, Order or direction, in the nature of a Writ, and to consider my representation given to the respondents 2 and 1 on 06.06.2015, in respect of Catering & TA Stall (S-18 & T-10) Plotform No.4 & 5 at Villupuram Railway Station.

Prayer in W.P.No.16974/2015: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, Order or direction, in the nature of a Writ, and to consider the representation given to the respondents 1 and 2 on 09.06.2015 in respect of Catering & Travel Amenity Stall (TPJ/S.25) and Fruit & Fruit Juice Stall (S.26) Platform No.1 & 2 at Villupuram Railway Station.

Prayer in W.P.No.16975/2015: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, Order or direction, in the nature of a Writ, and to consider the petitioner's representation given to the respondents 1 and 2 on 09.06.2015 in respect of Fruit & Fruit Juice Stall (S.17) P.F.No.1 & 2 Catering and Travelling Amenities Trolleys (T.11 T.12 T.13) and Sweet Trolley (T.18) at Villupuram Railway Station.
