Prayer: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural program in Sri Samundiswari Amman Temple Festival scheduled to be held on 1.7.2015 at Payanapalli Village, Natarampalli Taluk, Vellore District by considering petitioners representation dated 15.6.2015.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

The petitioner claims to be the President of the festival committee of Sri Samundiswari Amman Temple, situated at Payanapalli Village, Natarampalli Taluk, Vellore District and he submitted a representation/application dated 15.06.2015 to the 2nd respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 01.07.2015, in connection with the festival of the said temple, which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law and order problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4. This Court heard the submissions of Mr.Dig Vijaya Pandian, learned Additional Government Pleader, who accepts notice for the respondents.

5. This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the 2nd respondent to consider the application/representation dated 15.06.2015, in accordance with law and pass orders, as expeditiously as possible and not later than 29.06.2015 and inform the decision taken to the petitioner forthwith.

6. The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
