appearing for the respondents.

3. On a reading of the complaint it appears that the
petitioner had lent some money to the opposite party and that the
opposite party is not returning the money.

4. Since the matter is essentially civil in nature, no
positive direction can be given to the respondent police to

register an F.I.R. Hence, this petition is closed with the liberty to the petitioner to workout her remedy in the manner known to law.

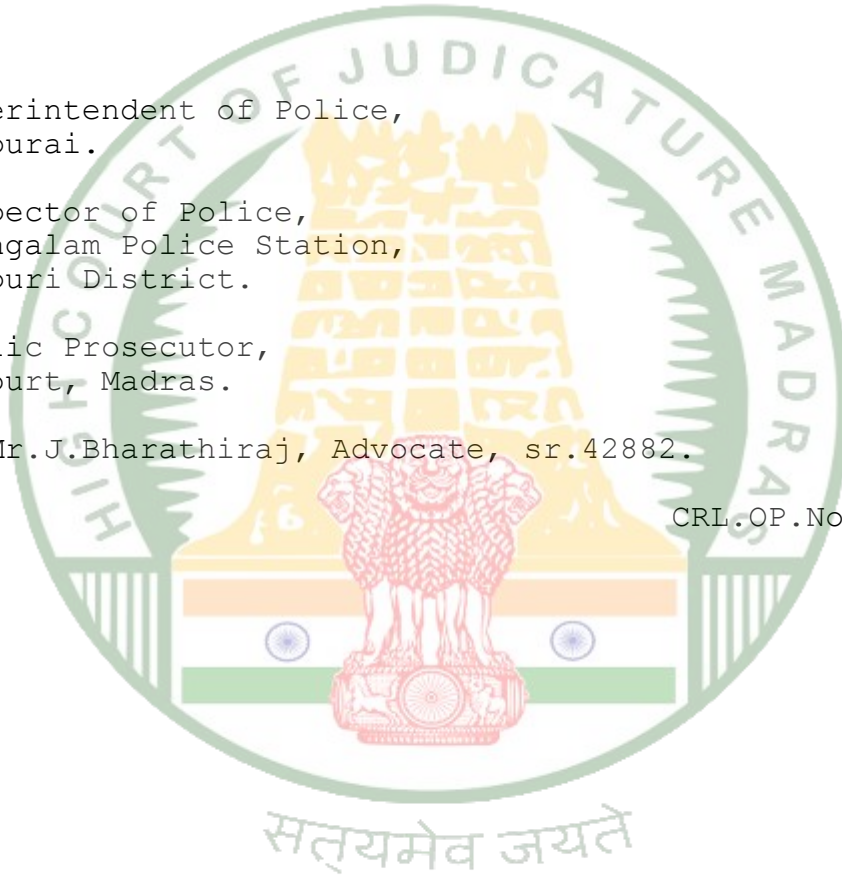
