ORDER

The petitioner is the wife and the respondent is the husband. The respondent / husband filed G.O.P.No.16 of 2014 on the file of Principal District Judge, Krishnagiri, seeking custody of minor children. The petitioner / wife now resides at Cheyyar Town and she is taking necessary steps to change her residence at Chennai. Hence, she has filed this petition to transfer the petition in G.O.P.No.16 of 2014 to the file of Family Court, Chennai.

2. On notice, the respondent has entered appearance through counsel.

3. It is well settled law that in matrimonial disputes, the convenience of wife is given preference in the matter of place of hearing. Hence, I am of the view that G.O.P.No.16 of 2014 pending on the file of the learned Principal District Judge, Krishnagiri has to be transferred to the file of Family Court, Chennai.

4. In the result, the transfer CMP is allowed and the

learned Principal District Judge, Krishnagiri is directed to transfer the petition in G.O.P.No.16 of 2014 pending on his file to the file of Family Court, Chennai for disposal. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
