In view of the narrow prayer made, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the second respondent to pass orders on the proposal, dated 03.08.2011, of the fourth respondent, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
