Insofar as the second prayer sought by the petitioner is concerned, learned Government Advocate appearing for respondents 1 and 2 submitted that by proceedings dated 29.04.2015, show cause notice has been issued to the 3rd respondent by the 2nd respondent. Hence, the second prayer has been satisfied.

3. As far as the first prayer sought by the petitioner is concerned, taking note of the pendency of the representation of the petitioner dated 09.05.2015, the 1st respondent is directed to consider the said representation and pass orders, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
