Government of Uttar Pradesh and Others reported in (2014) 2 SCC 1.

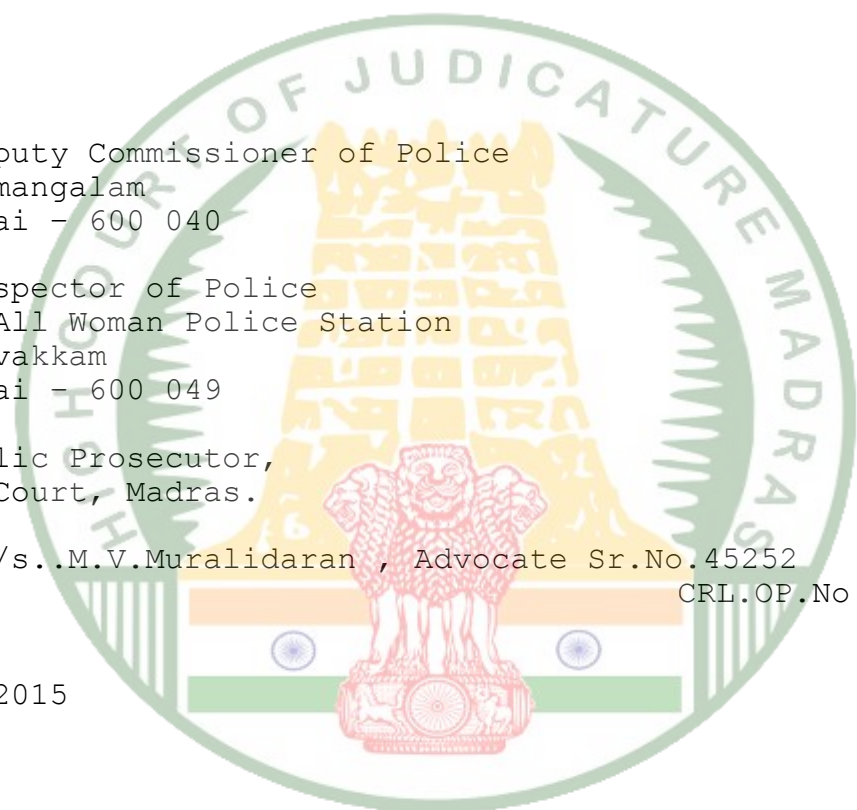
