Petition filed under Article 226 of the constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent to consider the representation dated 27.06.2015 and give permission to conduct the dance program on 07.07.2015 at about 7.00 p.m. to 10.30 p.m. to be held at Sri Muthumariamman Temple Thidal situated at Keelapettapalayam Village, Namakkal Taluk and District.

O R D E R

By consent of the learned counsel appearing on either side, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The petitioner claims to be the Secretary of the Vizha Committee of Sri Muthumariamman Temple situated at Keelapettapalayam Village, Namakkal Taluk & District. He submitted a representation dated 27.6.2015 to the respondent seeking permission to conduct a cultural programme in the temple, which includes song and dance programme to be held on 07.07.2015. Since the petitioner has not been favoured with any response, he came forward before this Court with the present writ petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in the event of permission granted by the respondent, there would not be any law and order problem and obscenity and vulgarity will not be there and prays for appropriate orders.

4. Heard the submissions of Mrs. P.Rajalakshmi, Government Advocate, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

5. This Court, in the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the representation dated 27.6.2015 made by the petitioner, directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 27.6.2015 and pass orders in accordance with law on or before 06.07.2015 and the respondent shall also communicate the decision taken to the petitioner.

6. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. However, there is no order as to costs.

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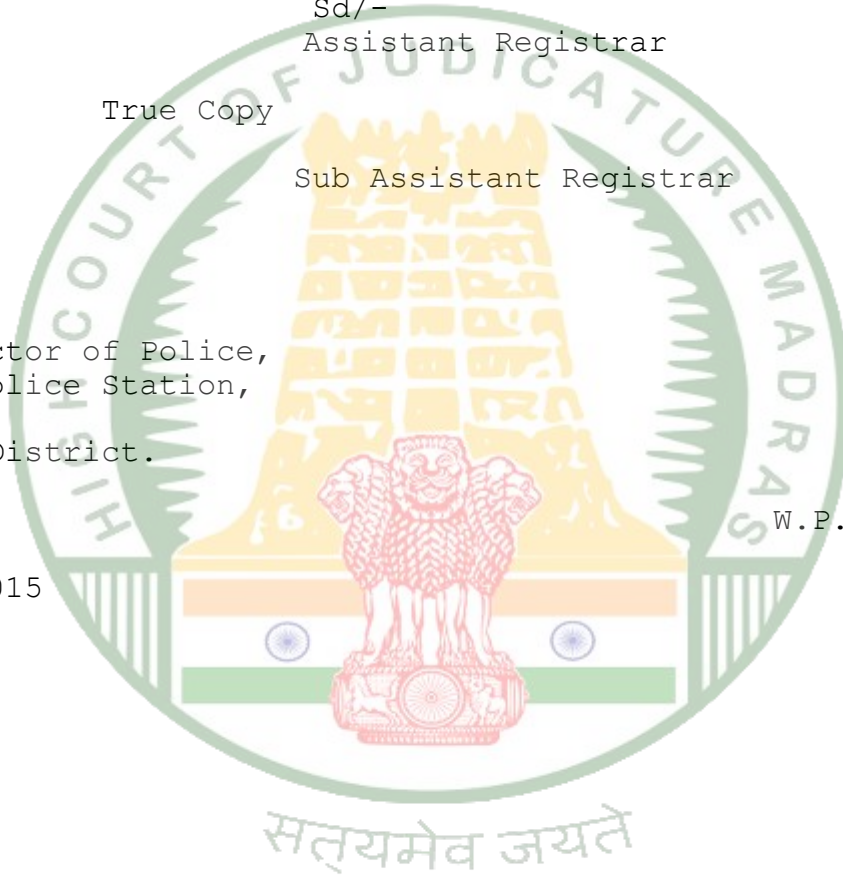
