COMMON ORDER

Seeking appropriate direction towards issuance of patta, the petitioner made applications on 16.08.2012 and 27.08.2012 to the first respondent. On their non-consideration, the present writ petitions have been filed.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that a communication has been sent by the first respondent stating that the applications made by the petitioner have been returned. However, no such applications have been received by the petitioner.

3. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that as and when the petitioner submits the applications, the same will be considered and appropriate orders will also be passed.

4. Considering the above said submissions, the petitioner is directed to send fresh applications to the respondents within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On receipt of the same, the first respondent shall pass appropriate orders without returning the applications on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity to the petitioner and the third parties, if any, within a period of eight weeks thereafter. It is made clear that if the first respondent wants any particulars, he can always ask the petitioner to produce the same.

The writ petitions are disposed of accordingly. No costs.
