The petitioner claims to be the Dharmakartha of Arulmighu Karupparayan Temple, situated at Sirumugai Road Karupparayan Thottam, Annur Taluk, Coimbatore District and he submitted a representation/application dated 27.06.2015 to the respondent, seeking permission to conduct Music, Dance and other cultural programme on 27.07.2015, in connection with the festival of the said temple and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law and order problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4. This Court heard the submissions of Mr.R.Vijaya Kumar, learned Additional Government Pleader, who accepts notice for the respondent.

the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the respondent to consider the application/representation dated 27.06.2015, in accordance with law and pass orders, as expeditiously as possible and not later than 25.07.2015 and inform the decision taken to the petitioner forthwith.

6. The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
