4. In the result, the transfer CMP is allowed and the learned Principal District Judge, Chengalpattu is directed to transfer the petition in I.D.O.P.No.193 of 2013 pending on his file to the file of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Chennai, for



disposal. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
