2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner; learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the 1st respondent and perused the
materials placed on record.

3. It is seen that this petitioner had purchased a property on
13.09.2012 measuring 2.42cents and that, in the year 2015, when he
approached the Village Administrative Officer, he was told by the
Village Administrative Officer that 0.60cents of land is there, in
the name of the petitioner. The dispute is civil in nature.

4. In the considered opinion of this Court, in a case of this nature, no positive direction can be issued as prayed for by the petitioner and this petition is closed, with liberty to the petitioner to workout his remedies in the manner known to law.

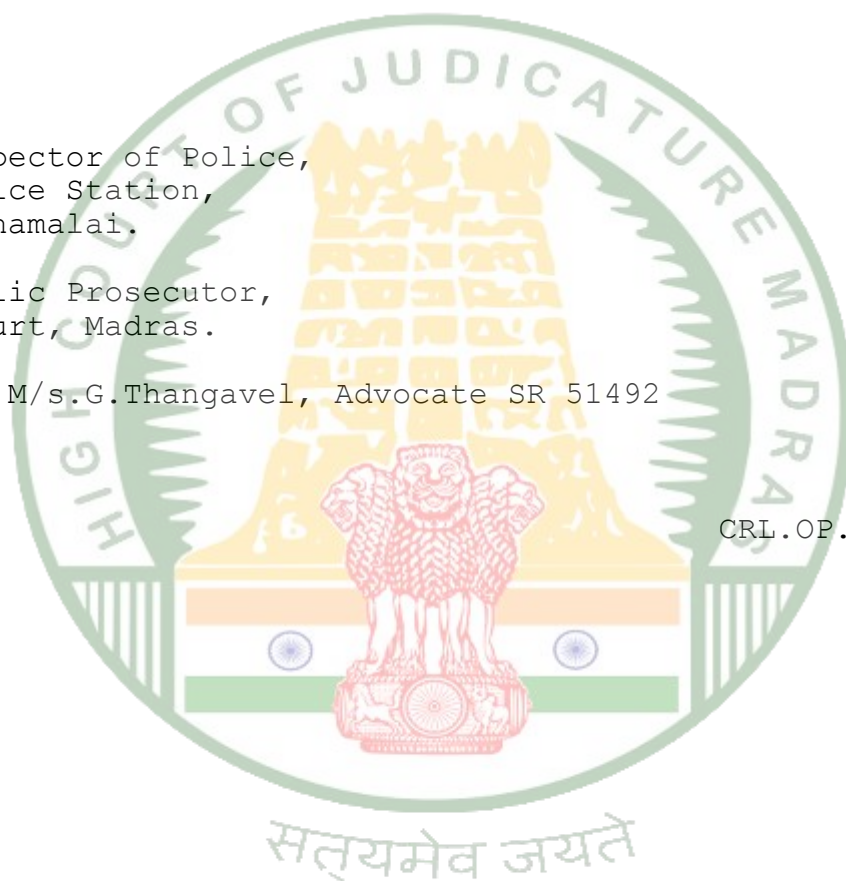
