2.According to the petitioners they are also entitled to the benefit of G.O.Ms.No.164 Rural Development Department dated 30.07.1992. It is also stated that persons similarly situated like the petitioners approached this Court by filing writ petitions and those writ petitions were allowed and the order was complied with by the Government by issuing G.O.Ms.No.85 Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, dated 11.09.2012. The petitioners individually and collectively made representation dated 27.06.2015 and 30.06.2015 seeking to give them the same benefit as given in G.O.Ms.No.85 Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, dated 11.09.2012.

3.In view of the narrow prayer made in the writ petition, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent to pass orders on the petitioners representation dated 27.06.2015 and 30.06.2015 in the light of G.O.Ms.No.85 Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, dated 11.09.2012 and on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
