O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

The petitioner claims to be the Dharmakartha of Kedagudayampattu Sri Mariamman Temple, situated in Kedagudayampattu Village, Kedagudayampattu Post, Sankarapuram Taluk, Villupuram District and he submitted a representation/application dated 14.07.2015 to the respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 27.07.2015, in connection with the festival of the said temple, which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law and order problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4. This Court heard the submissions of Mrs.P.Rajalakshmi, learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice for the respondent.

5. This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's application/representation dated 14.07.2015, in accordance with law and pass orders, as expeditiously as possible and not later than 26.07.2015 and inform the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6. The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
