O R D E R

The claim made by the petitioner for promotion to the post Assistant Inspector General of Registration was not considered on account of the pendency of a charge memo. The Government subsequently exonerated the petitioner from the charges. The Government have now passed an order in G.O(D)No.75 Commercial Taxes and Registration Department, dated 19.02.2015 promoting the petitioner to the post of Assistant Inspector General of Registration. In view of the subsequent events culminated in passing an order in G.O(D)No.75 Commercial Taxes and Registration Department, dated 19.02.2015 nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition.

2. The learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner retired from service on 30.06.2014 and as such a direction should be issued to the respondents to pay him the benefits as expeditiously as possible.

3. Since the petitioner retired as early as on 30.06.2014 and the Government have now promoted him to the post of Assistant Inspector General of Registration by order dated 19.02.2015, necessarily, all the benefits should be paid to him as expeditiously as possible and in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. The Writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs. Connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
