2. It is the case of the petitioner that on 04.08.2013, when there was a meeting of Youth Wing of the Party viz.,All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam Party and the Chief guest was the Education Minister, the Banners kept to welcome the Minister was torn by Chakravarthy, Muthukumar and Mukesh, who belonged to the same village and caused damage to the tune of Rs.50,000/-. Hence, a complaint was lodged and a case was registered in Crime No.444/2013 on the file of the respondent. 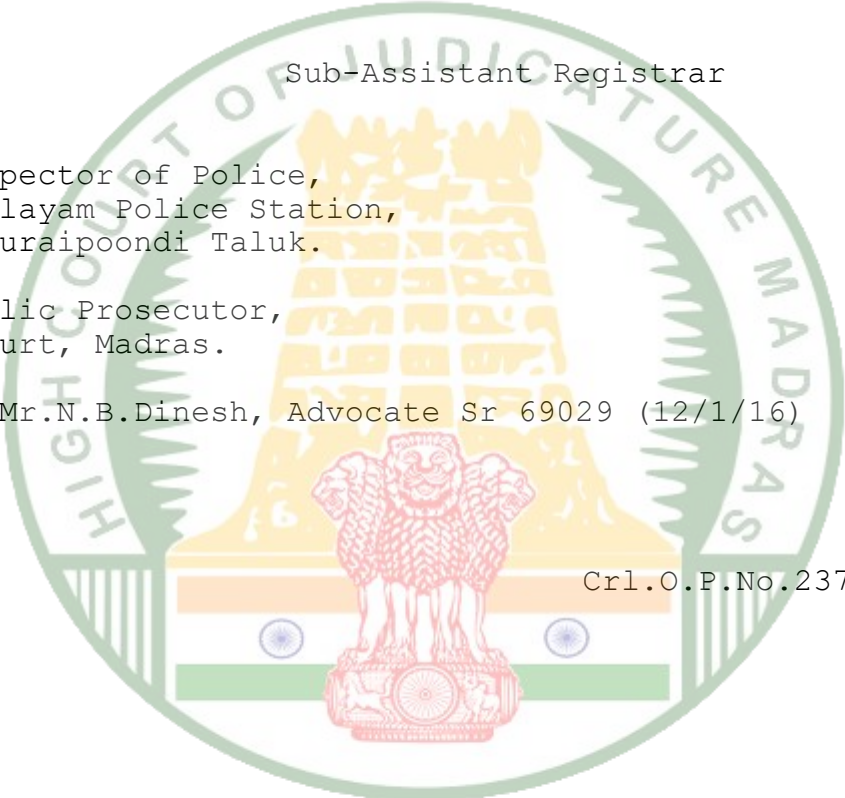
