Aggrieved over the non-furnishing of information by the 3rd respondent with regard to the affairs of the second respondent, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 5.3.2015 to the first respondent and since he has not favoured with any response, he came forward with this writ petition.

3. Heard the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Niranjan Rajagopalan, learned counsel appearing for M/s. G.R.Associates, who accepts notice on behalf of the first respondent and Mr.M.Digvijaya Pandian , learned Additional Government Pleader who accepts notice on behalf of the second and third respondents.

This Court, without going into the merits of the claim projected by the petitioner in this writ petition, directs the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 5.3.2015 in accordance with law after putting on notice to the persons concerned and pass orders within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken to the petitioner as well as to the persons concerned.

5. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
