By order, dated 17.11.2014, this Court appointed an Advocate Commissioner to seize and possess the vehicle in question. He was paid a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) as initial remuneration.

2. Pursuant to the warrant of commission issued by this Court to seize the vehicle, today, it is represented by the Advocate Commissioner that he has seized the vehicle. He has also filed a report and memo claiming additional remuneration before this Court.

3. Recording the fact that the vehicle has been seized, this application is closed.

4. Today, the learned Advocate Commissioner has sought for additional remuneration. Considering the same, a further sum of Rs...../- (Rupees Thousand only) is directed to be paid by the applicant as additional remuneration within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The Advocate Commissioner shall stand discharged.
