ORDER

Therefore, the persons, who lent money, are coming to the house of the petitioner looking out for her husband. Hence, no positive direction can be issued to the respondent police to register a case on the complaint given by the petitioner.

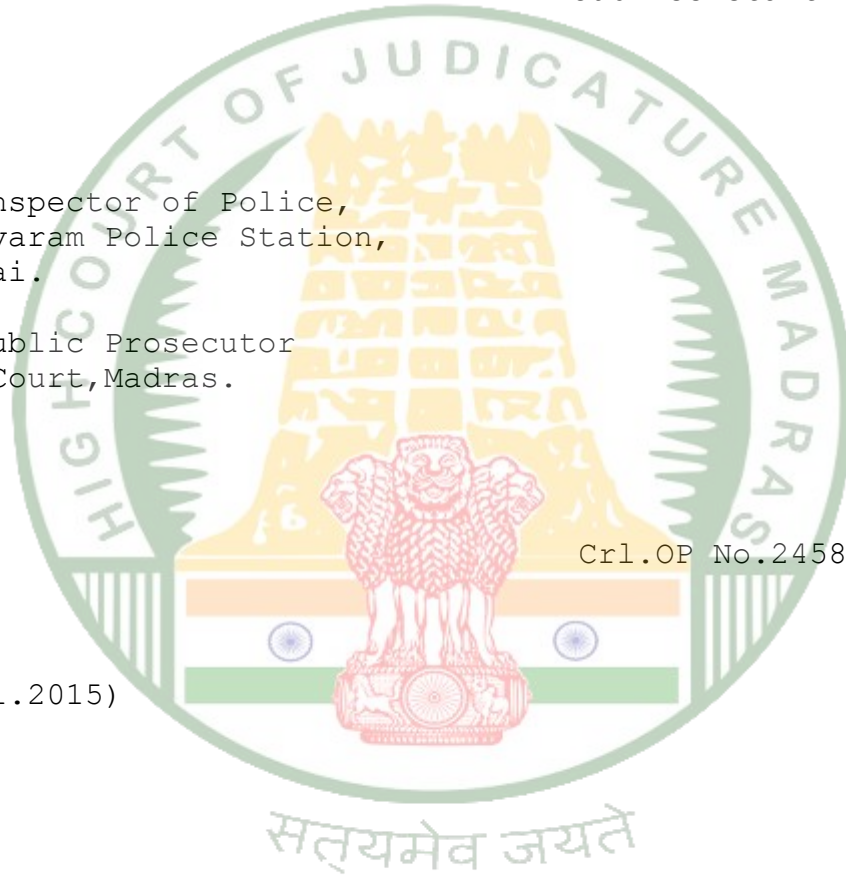
