2. The petitioner has filed this petition seeking a direction to the respondent to consider his application dated 21st May, 2015 and pass an order at the earliest.

3. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondent submits that if the application of the petitioner is still pending, the same shall be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks, in accordance with law and on its own merit.

4. In view of the above, we direct the respondent to consider the application of the petitioner, if it is pending on its file and pass an appropriate order, on merit and in accordance with law, preferably, within a period of eight weeks, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.

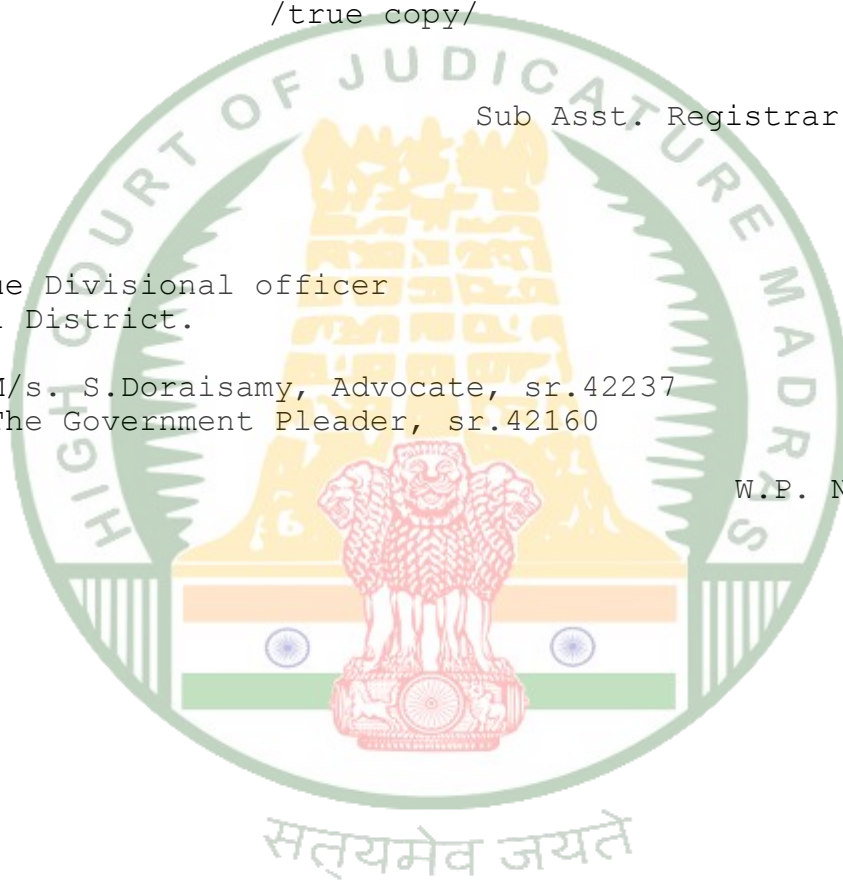
