2.The learned Additional Government Pleader submitted that the petitioner has filed the application under Section 64 (1) of the Hindu Religious & Charitable Endowment Act instead of Section 64 (4) of the Hindu Religious & Charitable Endowment Act.

4.The Writ Petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to file an application under Section 64 (4) of the Hindu Religious & Charitable Endowment Act within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On receipt of the same, the concerned authority is directed to look into the same and pass orders within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

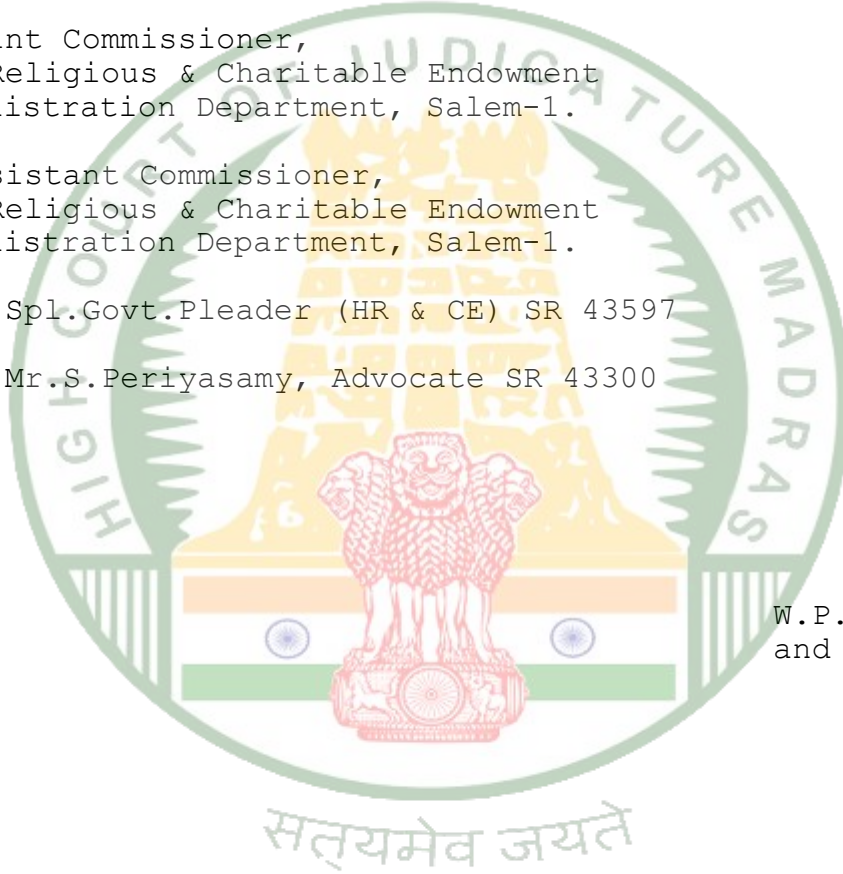
