Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to dispose the petitioner's representation on 10.3.2015 requesting to declare that the land situated in S.No.108/8 to the extent of 0.0150.5 square meter Kamakkapalayam Village Attur Taluk Salem District as ancestral property of the petitioner.

2 Claiming right pursuant to long possession from the ancestral property, petitioner made representation to the respondent on 10.3.2015 for issuance of certificate for the above said purpose. On its non-consideration, the present writ petition has been filed.

3 Taking into consideration the pendency of the representation, dated 10.3.2015, without going into the merits of the case, a direction is issued to the respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on the said representation within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is open to the respondent to hear any third party if so required.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.

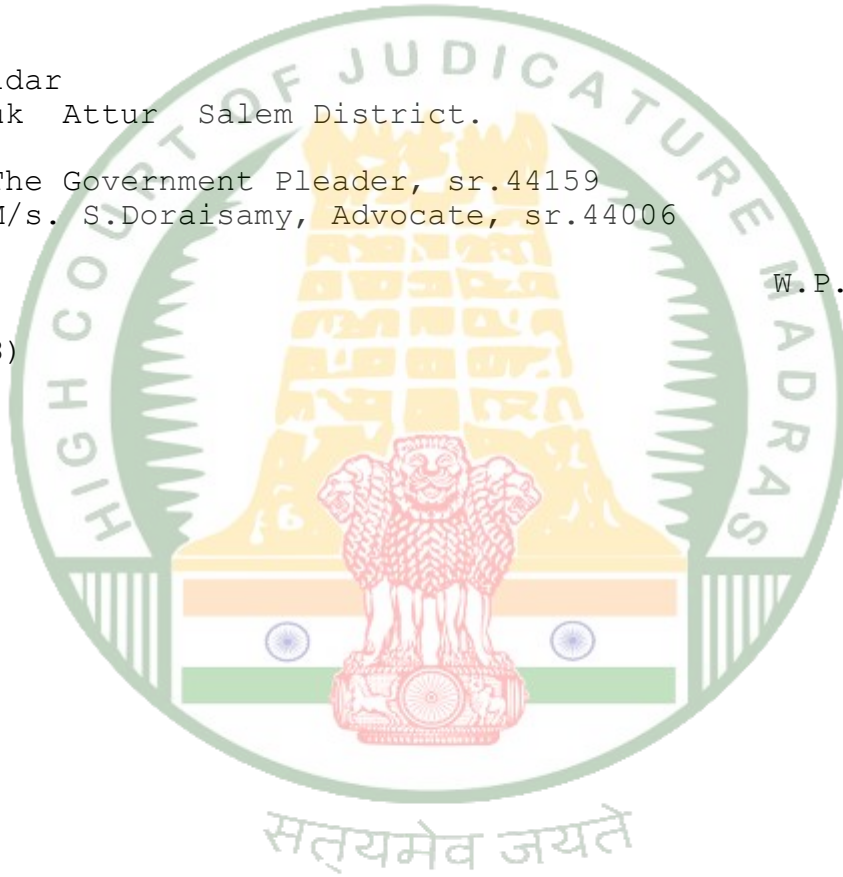
