Seeking appointment order to the post of Assistant Medical Officer (Unani) in the five vacancies reserved for Backward Class in pursuant to the notification No.48/2012, dated 16.11.2012, the petitioner made representations dated 02.09.2014, 05.09.2014 and 05.08.2015 respectively. In the said representations, the petitioner has made a reliance upon the Government Order in G.O.Ms.No.70, Health
