Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking for direction upon the learned First Additional Sessions Judge, (PCR) Thanjavur, to accept the surrender of the petitioner before him in connection with Cr.No.317 of 2014, on the file of the respondent- Inspector of Police, Manalmedu Police Station, Nagapattinam District and also to consider the petitioner's bail application on the same day.

O R D E R

The petitioner seeks for a direction upon the learned First Additional Sessions Judge, (PCR) Thanjavur, to consider his bail application on the same day in the event of his surrender in connection with a case in Crime No.317 of 2014, pending on the file of the respondent/Police.

2. The petitioner is an accused for offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294 (b), 323, 324 IPC read with Section 3 (1) (s) and 3(2) (va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

3. The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the respondent were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.

4. Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioner, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014, and that taking into custody of the petitioner, pending consideration of his bail application could cause him irreparable

hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the learned First Additional Sessions Judge, (PCR) Thanjavur, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on merits and pass appropriate orders on the same day of his surrender.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is ordered.
