PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the 2nd respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 20.08.2015 and release the Maruthi Swift Vehicle bearing Registration No.TN-01-AC-9581 seized by the 3rd respondent on 15.09.2013 to handover the vehicle to the petitioner.

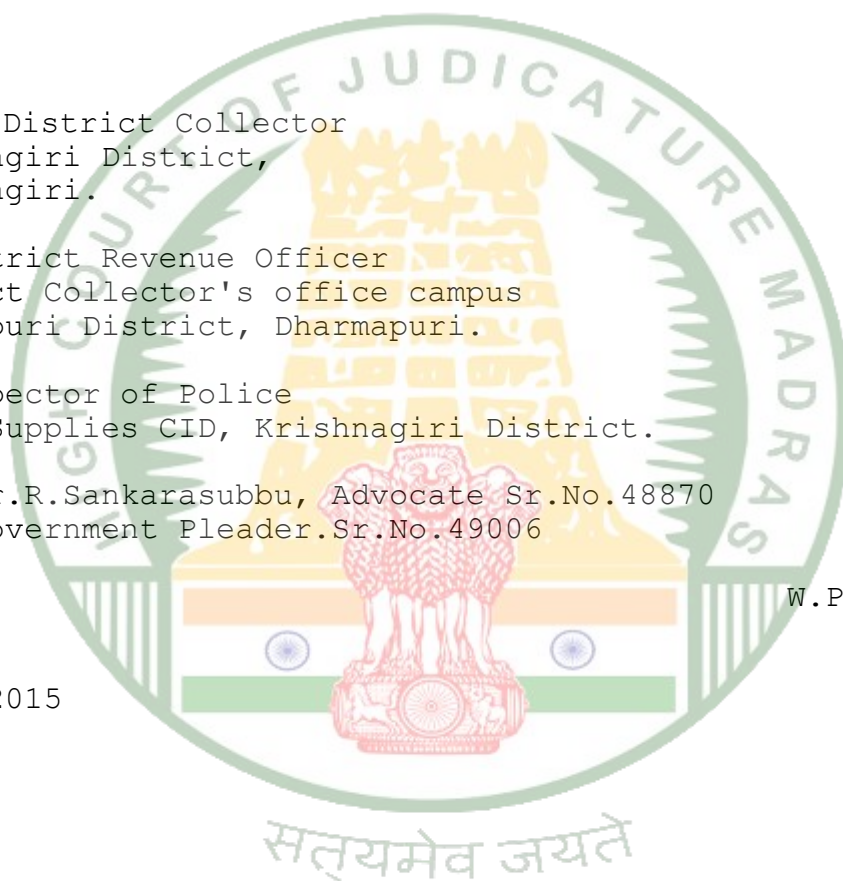
