within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order by filing an application under Section 70 (2) Cr.P.C to re-call the warrant in respect of C.C.No.218, 215, 213, 214, 217 and 216 of 2015 respectively and also by filing an affidavit before the concerned court to the effect that he will appear before the said court on all the hearing dates without fail and in the event of filing such an application, the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chengalpattu is directed to consider the same on the same day on merits and pass appropriate orders.

4.These criminal original petitions are disposed of accordingly.
