2. The petitioner herein has lodged a complaint as
against Ganesh and other and the said complaint was not
registered so far. Hence he has come forward with the present
petition.

3. Today, when the matter was taken up for
consideration, learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted
that the respondent police has already registered FIR in Crime
No.1088 of 2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 294
(b) and 506(i) of IPC.

4. Since a case was already registered on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, the prayer that has been made in the present petition has become infructuous. Hence, the criminal original petition is dismissed.

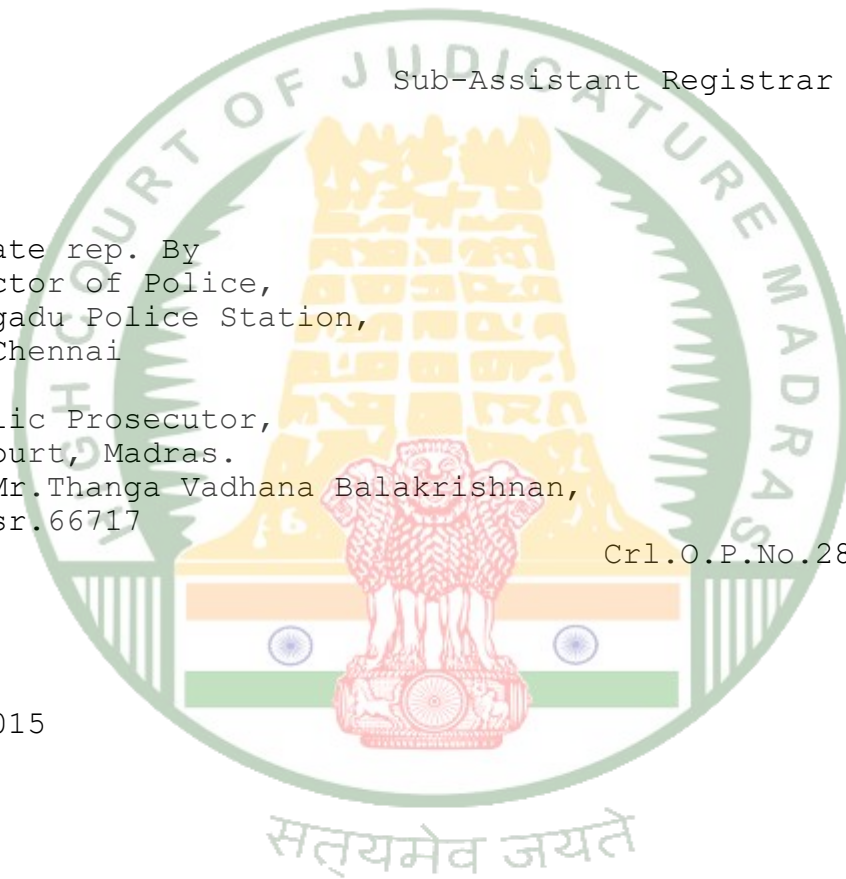
