Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus praying toa direction to the 1st respondent to regularize the service of the petitioner in any suitable post in accordance to his educational qualification and experience (length of service 11 years) by issuing necessary orders of relaxation of rules within a stipulated time limit.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsels appearing on behalf of the parties concerned.

2. At this stage of the hearing of the Writ Petition, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had submitted that it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the

first respondent to pass orders on the representation of the petitioner, dated 06.06.2011, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame specified by this Court. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the first respondent has no objection for this court passing such an order.

3. In such circumstances, this Court finds it appropriate to direct the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 06.06.2011, if it is otherwise in order, and dispose of the same, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, and the other persons concerned, if any, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner shall furnish a copy of the representation, dated 06.06.2011, to the first respondent, along with a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

4. The Writ Petition is disposed of, with the above directions. No costs.
