3.Heard the submissions of Mr.S.Vijayan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr.N.Srinivasan, learned Additional Government Pleader who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4.This Court taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the same, directs the respondents 1 and 2 to consider and dispose of the petitioners' joint representation dated 24.08.2015 on merits and in accordance with law and pass orders within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioners.

5.The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
